1. Welcome and apologies

3. Review of minutes of previous meeting, including actions

4. RoCoF workstream update

DH gave a verbal update to the Panel. DH advised that NIE Networks was not actively pressing non compliant generators due to the current prioritisation of the RoCoF worksteam.

7. TSO procurement of [11 out of 14] system services

b. MIC Charging Call for Evidence

IB gave a verbal update to the Panel. NIE Networks is currently developing a proposal for consultation. The intention is to publish the consultation by year end or early in the new year, and to write to affected customers in parallel with publishing the consultation. In order to facilitate the necessary additional customer engagement and to reduce the risk of over or under recovery following the change, NIE Networks is minded to recommend deferring the change to the 2020 tariff year.
